DAY 1: SINGAPORE - MUNICH

Troop down to Singapore Changi Airport where you will set off to **Munich**.

DAY 2: MUNICH



Highlights: Marienplatz, Olympic Stadium, Viktualienmarkt, Christmas Market

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to **Munich**, the third largest city in **Germany**. Enjoy the bustling **Viktualienmarkt**, an open-air market full of little stores selling freshly grilled sausages, fruits, flowers and cheese. Here, the **Christmas market** will be in full swing with an entrancing festival of light and music.

DAY 3: MUNICH - HALLSTATT - SALZBURG



Highlights: Hallstatt, Salzburg Christmas Market

DAY 5: INNSBRUCK - FREIBERG - STRASBOURG



Highlights: Historical Merchants' Hall

DAY 10: INTERLAKEN - BERN - ZURICH



Highlights: Clock Tower, Bern Bear Park, Grossmünster, Fraumünster, Christmas Market

Begin your trip with a scenic drive to Bern, the capital of Switzerland. Upon arrival, proceed to Bahnhofplatz, the medieval centre of Bern. Embark on a walking tour and take in genteel streetscapes of Renaissance-style fountains and cobblestone laneways and keep your eyes peered for the 16th-century astronomical **Clock Tower**. A short walk away, you will find house No. 49, once Albert Einstein's home. Do not miss a visit to the iconic **Bern Bear Park**. Thereafter, proceed to **Zurich** to see the imposing Grossmünster and the elegant Fraumünster churches and meander through winding alleys of the Old Town alongside River Limmat. A highlight is Europe's biggest indoor **Christmas market** held in the main railway station, with over 160 wooden chalets and a three-stories Christmas tree, draped with thousands of sparkling Swarovski crystals.
